Terms of Reference

The working languages of the Network are English, French and German.

The Network's members will:

- meet once per year
- o send maximum two participants, fully briefed, to each meeting
- o rotate the duty of hosting the annual meeting (host country to support the meeting -ICT facilities, any administrative support)
- review the Network's membership at the annual meeting
