Speak with Us! – Classroom

Fremmedspråksenteret har laget ressursen *Speak with Us!* Den består av 10 kort med forslag til hvordan man kan ordlegge seg på engelsk i overgangssituasjoner som er i klasserommet.

- If you need help, please raise your hand.

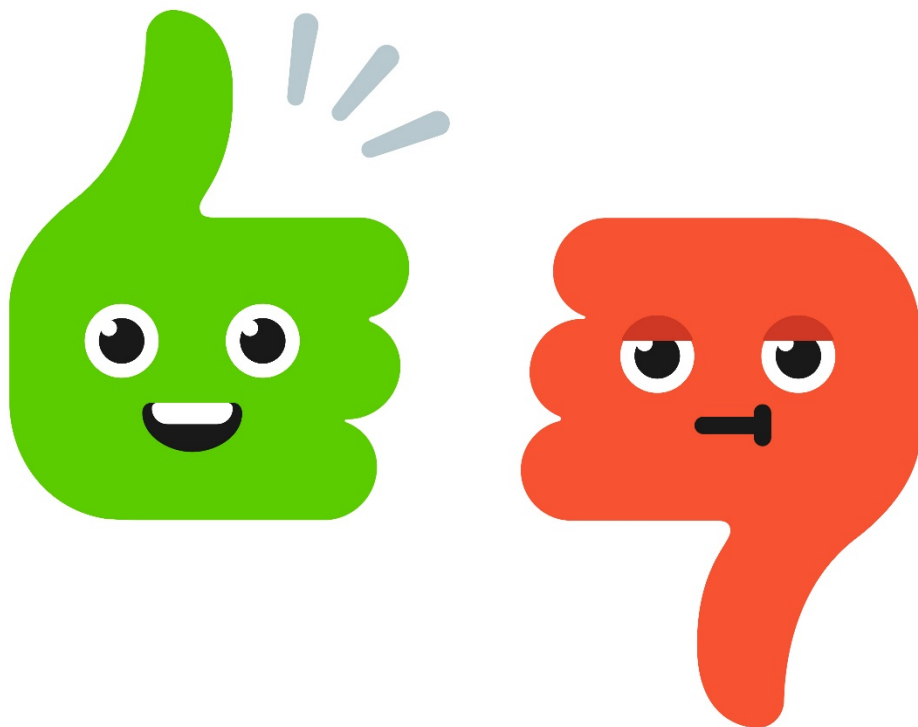
End of the Day

- Have a safe walk/ride/trip home.

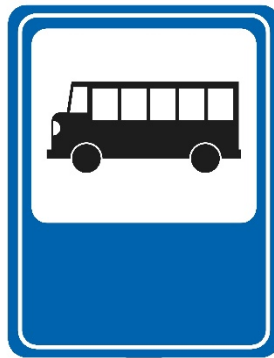
Feedback

- Have a nice day/break/weekend/holiday!

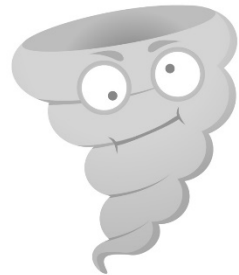
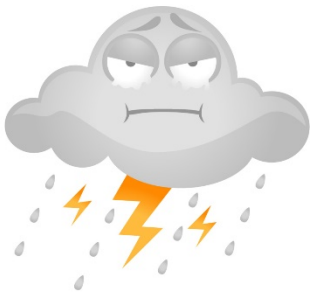
Group Work
