Task 4:

Come up with 1 short conversation where you use B.A.G.S. Work with somebody sitting close to you in the classroom. Use a digital tool to create your conversation. Share it with someone and get some good ideas you can use yourself.

Task 5:

Small talk can help you and somebody else have a good time.

Prepare some questions for the party but be prepared to make follow up questions on the spot! It means you show an interest (you are **inquisitive** = nysgjerrig) and really listen when you are talking to someone.

Use your knowledge of films, music, sports, nature, books, subjects, games, teachers, future plans and fun things to do where you live. Maybe there's a haunted house somewhere? Maybe something really interesting happened in the classroom and you didn't dare to comment on it in front of everyone else. Or maybe this is your chance to finally talk to someone you have been waiting to talk to for a long time? You can give a complement and make use of the situation to make a good impression. Try to make some questions using "to think" or "to mean" as well.
