Project on First Aid – Student Handout

Work in groups of 2 or 3.

1. Choose a first aid case:

→ which means that an accident or a life-threatening situation has occurred and someone has been injured and is in desperate need of help.

Examples of such cases:

- → heart failure/heart attack
- → car accident with various kinds of injuries
- → drowning- you find a lifeless person in the water
- → someone having been in a fire and been seriously burned
- → someone has broken a leg
- → someone has been skiing and injured his/her neck
- → you find an unconscious person outside on a cold day
- → someone has had an accident bicycling and suffers from arterial bleeding
- → someone has got an object in his/her throat and can't breathe
- → someone suffers from internal bleeding

Feel free to make your own cases as well.

- 2. Vocabulary list: make a list of words that you will need in order to describe and act out your case.
- 3. Describe the situation. What do you see when you come to the place of the accident/injury?
- 4. Given the nature of your case, what is the first thing you have to do?
- 5. As a first aider, what will you do to help the person who is injured or suffers from a life threatening situation? Make a detailed description of how you would treat the injured person.
- 6. Practice and act out the case in your group.

Final step: You will present your case to another group and ask them what they would have done in such a situation and then teach them what to do if they don't know what to do. You will also teach them the vocabulary they need to use.
