# MENU - Pair work/Group work

### Task

Working together in pairs you should come up with a menu for a special occasion. You should also include venue, table settings and styles of serving to suit your menu. This shall be presented in class as a PowerPoint-presentation.

The occasion might be things such as;

- christening/name giving celebration
- confirmation
- wedding/wedding anniversary
- birthday celebration
- company jubilee
- gala
- or something else you think is worth a celebration ...




#### Contents

- 1. A description of what occasion you choose, how many guests and whether some of the guests have special diets.
- 2. A description of where the menu will be served, either a specific venue you know of, or a room (i.e. a small pub, a restaurant, a conference room, etc.)
- 3. A presentation of the menu (minimum three courses) and why you chose those dishes.
- 4. A presentation of the table settings, decorations and style of serving the menu.
- 5. A conclusion on whether you think your menu/serving style could be done in a real life situation, and why.

## Evaluation

The evaluation will be based on:

- The PowerPoint presentation (contents and how it's structured).
- The presentation (use of voice, pronunciation, speaking freely vs. reading, eye-contact).



#### There will be given two marks:

- 1. Individual mark: how well each one takes part in the presentation, knows the contents and is able to speak English
- 2. Group mark: the contents in the Power Point and how well the group present it to the class
