

General, qualitative description of valuation criteria

A	Excellent	An excellent performance, clearly outstanding. The candidate demonstrates excellent judgement and a very high degree of independent thinking.
B	Very good	A very good performance. The candidate demonstrates sound judgement and a high degree of independent thinking.
C	Good	A good performance in most areas. The candidate demonstrates a reasonable degree of judgement and independent thinking in the most important areas.
D	Satisfactory	A satisfactory performance, but with significant shortcomings. The candidate demonstrates a limited degree of judgement and independent thinking.
E	Sufficient	A performance that meets the minimum criteria, but no more. The candidate demonstrates a very limited degree of judgement and independent thinking.
F	Fail	A performance that does not meet the minimum academic criteria. The candidate demonstrates an absence of both judgement and independent thinking.

As described in Canvas and the document: "Project management autumn 2018":

*Delivery at end of semester:*

- 1. A document which shall be delivered to an investor.*
- 2. A moodtape to describe the experience/feeling of using the product.*
- 3. Documents produced in the semester as a base for the investor document.*
- 4. A description of processes the group accomplished with a reflection against the plans in delivery: 2.*
- 5. A pitch to present the product and plans for investors.*

The document (#1) shall be produced in the quality, style and content you want to give to a possible investor. This implicate information of the product, plans needed for managing the process of development, and other things of interest for an investor regarding your product. The product should be an interactive story telling.

The document (#3) are in the course named as a collection of *Internal documents*. This document shall start with a list of contents. This collection of documents shall be the foundation for the content in doc #1, and the Pitch (#5).

The document (#4) is an individual delivery for each candidate.

The documents delivered in week 47 on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> November shall be evaluated with Bestått/ikke Bestått.

To have “Bestått” each of the elements #1, #2, #3 should at least be evaluated to:

*A good performance in most areas. The candidate demonstrates a reasonable degree of judgement and independent thinking in the most important areas.*

It is required to have “Bestått” to attend the Pitch (#5).

The Pitch (#5) together with (#1) and (#2) should give an individual grade A-F.
