## Fast track course

Starting date: 11. Or 17. September. 2023

End date: 31. March. 2024

This is a course intended for newly arrived refugees from Ukraina who wish to attend higher education in Norway. However, refugees from all countries are welcome to apply. During a period of 30 weeks this course will prepare you for Norskprøven at level B1-B2 in April. Included in the course, is one paid try at the test. There will be online classes twice a week, and each class lasts for two hours. It is therefore expected that the students spend approximately 8 hours per week at self study in addition to classes. Powerpoint presentations and study materials will be available for all participants, and it will be possible to follow the course without attending every class. Still, we strongly recommend the participants to attend classes, as this is necessary to be able to follow the quick progression plan. It is also expected that the participants turn in oral and written assignments throughout the course. These will not be graded, but is used to give feedback and evaluate the level of the participant.

Course days are not yet set, everyone who is interested in attending the course, will have the opportunity to answer a questionnaire with possible days and time, and we will choose the options that is convenient for most.

In this fast track course, you will learn about Norwegian literature, music, culture, politics and history, as well as language and grammar. We will focus on writing and oral skills, and practice reading and listening.
