Including its castle, classified as a historic monument (Home of the famous counts of Geneva, the immaculately preserved building now houses a museum and ephemeral exhibitions), the old prisons of the Palais de l'Isle (Initially toll zone on the Thiou, the building quickly became alternately a prison, an asylum or a court, today to house the splendid exhibitions of the Center of Interpretation of Architecture and Heritage).
